Kingdom International Prep Program Guidelines

1. Screening and Host Family Orientation

- Background checks and references for selected host families will be conducted prior to placement of student-athletes.
- Host families will be required to attend a program orientation on program rules, emergency procedures, and cultural sensitivity.
- Host families will be provided an overview of the mission of the program and their role.
- Host families must respect all cultural, religious and personal differences of student-athletes in their care.
- Host families are not allowed to have a teenage child of the opposite gender in order to participate in the program.

2. Communication

- Clear communication will be maintained between host families, players, and program staff through weekly updates from the program director.
- Families will be assigned a designated staff member for support and to handle conflict and disciplinary issues.

3. Financial Arrangements

- Host families will be provided a \$500 monthly stipend on the 1st of every month to offset costs.

4. Program Expenses

- Some student incidentals will be handled through the program such as toiletries and some personal effects. The program will provide athletic gear that includes two pairs of shoes, three pairs of shorts, three shirts, a backpack and a travel suit to be stored by the program.

5. Medical Expenses

- Student medical costs will be maintained by parents.
- The program will provide student health insurance to cover basic needs, however, any extensive testing and/or treatment will be covered by the parents.

6. Host Families Supervision and Support



Kingdom International Prep Program Guidelines

- Host families are expected to provide a clean, safe and welcoming environment for student-athletes as well as a supportive, family-oriented environment for the athletes to thrive.
- The host will provide a private bedroom, bed and adequate space for personal belongings.
- The host will also provide healthy meals each day and accommodate reasonable dietary needs or restrictions.
- Ensure student-athletes can thrive academically, athletically, and socially while away from home.
- The host will offer parental guidance, but allow independence appropriate for the student's age.
- It is recommended that host families encourage students to participate in family activities to foster a sense of belonging and connection.
- No major decisions should be made regarding the student without consulting the student's legal guardian (program director).

7. Transportation

- Host families will provide weekday transportation to and from the practice facility and other group events.
- The program will provide transportation to and from school.

8. Student-Athlete Responsibilities

- Student-athletes will abide by host family rules, curfews, chores and household expectations.
- Students will show respect for the host family members, their property and cultural differences.
- Students will attend school regularly, complete assignments and maintain a passing average.
- It is the students responsibility to communicate with teachers and coaches if extra support is needed.
- Student-athletes are expected to attend all scheduled practices, games, and team activities unless excused due to illness or emergency by a coach.
- Student-athletes are expected to maintain fitness, nutrition and time management.
- Students are expected to keep open communication with host family, program staff and teachers.
- It is the students responsibility to alert coaches of any issues at home or school or personal in nature.

9. Code of Conduct



Kingdom International Prep Program Guidelines

- Program participants are prohibited from the use of illegal drugs, underage drinking, or inappropriate behavior.
- Social media use must reflect positively on the individual, program and host family.
- All program participants must respect all cultural, religious and personal differences of program participants, host families and program staff.

10. Conflict Resolution

- Minor issues should be addressed directly with the host family first.
- For ongoing challenges, notify the program director.
- If unresolved, the student may be reassigned to another host family.

11. Safety & Emergency Procedures

- Clear steps for accidents, illness, or emergencies will be explained to both host families and athletes during orientation.
- Host families will be provided the emergency contact information for program staff, school, and medical providers.
- Host families will have access to student's health insurance coverage for emergency purposes.
- Program staff should be contacted immediately if a student emergency occurs.
- Any concerns regarding student safety and well-being must be reported to the program staff.

12. Cultural Exchange & Enrichment

- Host families are asked to encourage athletes to share their culture through food, traditions, and conversation.
- Host families should expose athletes to local customs, holidays, and family activities.
- The program is designed to support positive cross-cultural experiences for both the host families and the students.
